Later, the group will visit Tiananmen Square, the largest public square in the world and the site of the Heroes Memorial and the Mao Zedong Mausoleum. Tiananmen Square is flanked on the east by the National Museum of History and on the west by the Great Hall of the People. To the north of the Square stands the main gate to the sprawling Forbidden (Imperial) City, where participants will tour the classical buildings that were home to a succession of imperial dynasties. The sightseeing itinerary will give delegates the opportunity to visit the impressive grounds of the emperors' Summer Palace and the famous Temple of Heaven.
